



## TERMS OF GRANT GIVING

Wiltshire Gardens Trust (WGT) has a programme of Giving for which we invite applications from those organisations, or individuals that fulfil the criteria below.

Typically, each donation amounts to a maximum of £5000 per annum.

Successive applications can be made to fund capital, therapy or education projects on an ongoing basis.

Grants are not made for living materials i.e. plants or trees.

### WGT CRITERIA FOR GRANT GIVING

**You must be a Charity, Community Interest Group or Individual within Wiltshire working on the following:**

- 1. Gardens or gardening related projects as therapy**
- 2. Gardens as an educational resource**
- 3. Professional garden training**

Applications can only be made using the WGT Application Form. Once received this is assessed by the WGT Giving Team. If the criteria for giving are met, consideration will be made at the following Council meeting that typically take place on a bi-annual basis.

Applications will be given a grant, declined or more information requested. If successful, applicants will receive a letter of confirmation and asked to sign up to an agreement to provide regular project updates and access for an annual visit by a WGT Trustee.
